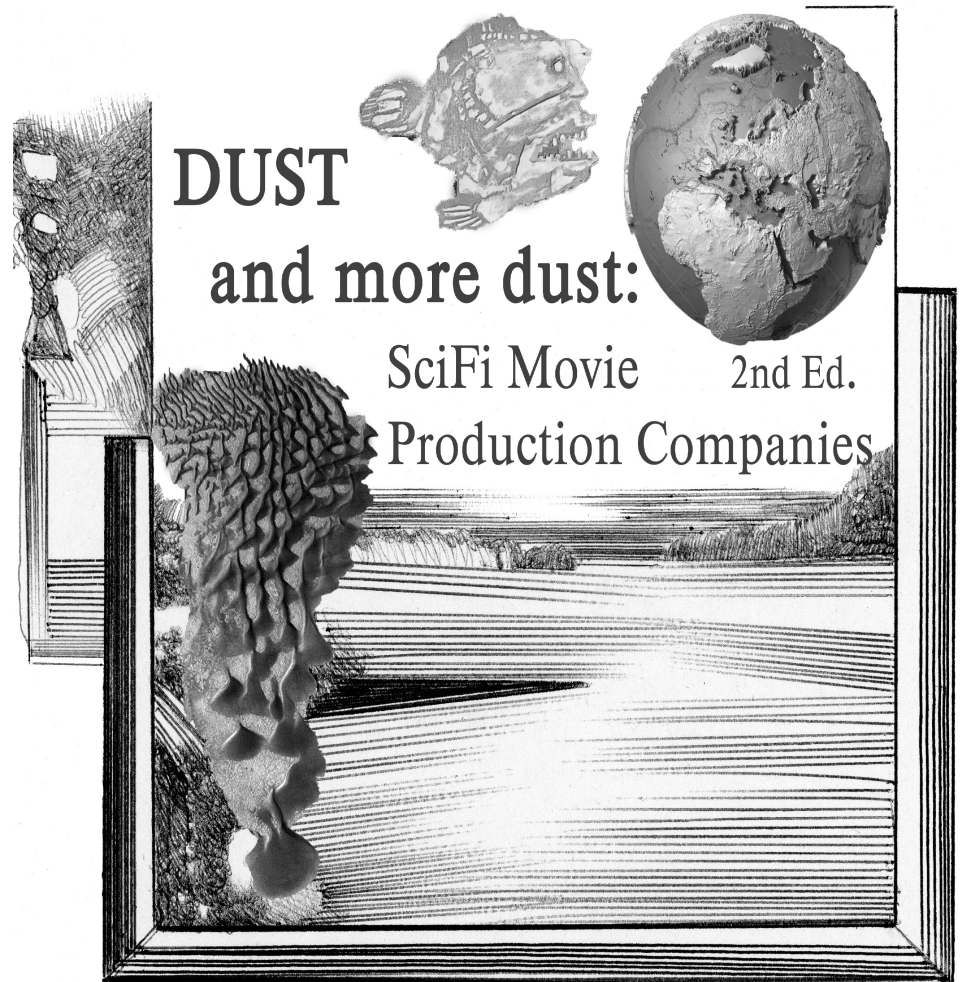

ABC Motion Pictures

ABC returned to theatrical film production in May 1979 as ABC Motion Pictures; it was incorporated by June 11, 1980. ABC Motion Pictures was a boutique production company, and only made a few theatrical films a year. The studio's films were released by 20th Century-Fox Film Corporation (now 20th Century Studios). Although it mainly made films, it also produced TV movies, series and mini-series. One of the studio's films, The Flamingo Kid, was pulled from release by Fox so the company could stop spending money on advertising, despite the movie doing well. ABC shut down the studio's theatrical motion picture operation on October 28, 1985, after the release of only 6 theatrical films; the move came within weeks of rival CBS shutting down CBS Theatrical Films. The unit released one more movie, Space Camp, already produced in the summer of 1985. The Walt Disney Company owns the rights to the ABC Motion Pictures library (and currently own the library through 20th Century Studios after that company was brought by Disney in 2019). Disney has licensed the home media rights to Kino Lorber Films, after being previously licensed to Embassy Home Entertainment, Vestron Video, Image Entertainment, Anchor Bay, and MGM Home Entertainment.

TORONTO - Ian Greenberg, the Montreal media mogul who alongside his brothers grew Astral Media into a radio and television powerhouse, has died at 79. Broadcast giant BCE Inc., where Greenberg served as a board member after the acquisition of his company, said he died Monday. "Canada has lost a business visionary and media legend, and we at Bell have lost a wise and affable colleague and friend," BCE chair Gordon Nixon said in a statement. Greenberg was remembered by friends and colleagues as firmly dedicated to the success of his business and the love of his family, who played a major role in his career. He was eager to mentor those he felt held the skills for success. Greenberg was born in Montreal to an Ashkenazi Jewish family of 10 that included his brothers Harold, Harvey and Sidney. Several of the Greenbergs worked

in a camera store as teens. That experience inspired them to take a \$15,000 loan from a close relative and invest it in a film processing business called Angreen Photo Inc., named after their mother. Small acquisitions expanded their investments into motion picture processing, while they secured the exclusive rights to sell photo products at Expo 67. Within a few years, they were dipping their toes into film and TV production, including the feature, "The Apprenticeship of Duddy Kravitz" starring Richard Dreyfuss in 1974 and "City on Fire," a Montreal-filmed disaster flick, in 1978.

Bad Robot is an American film and television production company founded on May 27, 1999, and led by Katie McGrath and J.J. Abrams as Co-CEO. Under its Bad Robot Productions division, the company is responsible for the television series Alias, Lost, Fringe, Person of

Interest, Revolution, and Westworld alongside the feature-length films Cloverfield, Star Trek, Super 8, Star Trek Into Darkness, Mission: Impossible – Ghost Protocol, Mission: Impossible – Rogue Nation, Star Wars Episodes VII and IX, 10 Cloverfield Lane, Star Trek Beyond, The Cloverfield Paradox, Mission: Impossible – Fallout, and Overlord. Bad Robot was originally based at Touchstone Television, but was moved by J.J. Abrams to Paramount Pictures and Warner Bros. Television. Bad Robot produced Lost in association with ABC Studios, formerly Touchstone Television. The two companies jointly produced Six Degrees and What About Brian. Abrams is Chairman and Co-Chief executive officer of Bad Robot, and Katie McGrath serves as the Company's Co-Chief executive officer. In June 2017, Bad Robot announced that Brian Weinstein would become President and Chief Operating Officer, overseeing daily operations and spearhead the company's growth strategy in its existing businesses, while developing new areas of expansion across the entire Bad Robot platform and pursuing alternative financing options. In May 2015, Although some fans believe that the name comes from a line in the animated film On July 7, 2016, the PASS Time game mode became official. Bad Robot released a trailer entitled "Stranger" (otherwise known as S.), rumoured to be Abrams' next film or television project, perhaps even a Lost spin-off, but it was finally explained to be promoting S., Abrams and Doug Dorst's new novel, as a new trailer for S. was released. Bad Robot Productions is currently based in Santa Monica, California, in a building which is incorrectly labeled on purpose as the home of the fictional "National Typewriter Company" because Abrams "likes typewriters – and misdirection."

In 2016, the Hellenic Film Academy Award was officially named as the 'Iris'. The Hellenic Film Academy is a member of the Film Academy Network of Europe. The company signed a deal with Atlas Entertainment in 1994, allowing Classico to finance films for Atlas. In 1995, Levinsohn and fellow film producer Mark Gordon decided to merge their own companies, forming Cloud Nine Entertainment. The company focused on the co-production and

financing of feature films; the company also created an international sales division and finalized a multi-year equity partnership with the BBC, Tele-München Gruppe, Toho-Towa/Marubeni and UGC-PH. The four companies financed a combined 60% (15% each) of the films' budgets in exchange for distribution rights in their respective territories (the United Kingdom, Germany, Japan and France) and equity stakes in the films on a worldwide basis. On September 9, Gordon left Mutual to relaunch his own company film producer Don Granger joined the company on February 13, Mutual's output has been slow after Lara Croft: Tomb Raider - The Cradle of Life and Timeline both underperformed; the company has only worked on three films since then: Snakes on a Plane, Deadfall and Jack Reacher (Mutual went uncredited for Reacher).

Nederland Film Funds

The Netherlands Film Fund (Dutch: Nederlands Filmfonds) is a subsidy fund for Dutch film productions and was founded in 1993. It is itself mainly subsidized by the Dutch Ministry of Education, Culture and Science. In 2007, the total budget of the fund was €33,000,000. The fund gave €651,174 subsidy to the film *Character* (1997) and €578,570 to the film *Black Book* (2006). Since 2001, the Netherlands Film Fund and the Netherlands Film Festival recognize box office results of Dutch films with awards. Currently, there are four different box office awards: the Crystal Film (10,000 visitors for documentary films), the Golden Film (100,000 visitors), the Platinum Film (400,000 visitors), and the Diamond Film (1,000,000 visitors).

New Extreme Films

(New Extremity or, also often, New French Extremity) describes a range of transgressive films made at the turn of the 21st century that sparked controversy, and provoked significant debate and discussion. They were notable for including graphic images of violence, especially sexual violence and rape, as well as explicit sexual imagery. The films cannot be described as part of a movement or a wave, and the term 'new extreme' was never assumed by film makers. The term 'extreme' tends moreover to apply to individual films rather than film makers, with many directors only making a single film that might be considered new extreme. Rather, the term 'new extreme' was adopted by critics, scholars, and viewers to describe a cinematic trend for graphic sexual and violent imagery, especially in France but across Europe more generally beginning in the late 1990s.

offering both bachelor's and master's degrees, and is situated in the city centre of Leeds. School was established in 1970 in Leeds, West Yorkshire, England. As far back as the late 1960s, the nationally recognized Leeds Polytechnic Film Unit played a part in launching the careers of several luminaries of the British Film Industry. In 1991, it became The Northern School of Film and Television, before changing its name to The Northern Film School, offering courses in screen writing and film production. The school later merged with Leeds Metropolitan University, but still retained its status as a film school. Unlike the larger film schools, such as the National Film School and the London Film School, the merge offered students a film school experience at an affordable university fee. Influence The Northern Film School is the largest of its kind in the north of England. The school has close working relationships with Screen Yorkshire and ITV participates in local, regional, national and international film festivals.

The studio was originally a production/distribution/sales organization, which usually co-released and internationally released films by other studios (such as Touchstone Pictures, 20th Century Fox (now 20th Century Studios), and Warner Bros.), but they became fully independent in 2006; their first film as a fully independent studio was *P2* in 2007. The next year, Summit released *Twilight* (based on the novel by Stephenie Meyer), which spawned a film series spanning four sequels and brought a huge success for the studio. On January 13, 2012, Lionsgate Films acquired Summit for \$412.5 million.

The Asylum Films

The Asylum is an American independent film company and distributor that focuses on producing low-budget, direct-to-video films. The company has produced titles that capitalize on productions by major studios, often using film titles and scripts very similar to those of current blockbusters in order to lure customers. These titles have been dubbed "mockbusters" by the press. The Asylum is an American film production and distribution company based in Burbank, California. The company is known for producing low-budget, direct-to-video films, in particular mockbusters, which capitalize on the popularity of major studio films with similar titles and premises. The Asylum's business model revolves around producing as many low-budget films as quickly as possible, which earn around \$150,000 to \$250,000 in profit. Since the company produces dozens of films every year, this model generates millions of dollars, and the company claims to have never lost money on a film. The Asylum spends around 4-6 months making a film, and since the company is not affiliated with any industry guilds other than SAG-AFTRA, this means their employees will sometimes work upwards of 22 hours a day. Initially founded as a distribution company for low-budget drama films, The Asylum switched to in-house productions in the mid-2000s due to competition from larger studios like Lionsgate Films. In 2005, The Asylum released the film H. G. Wells' War of the Worlds the day before Steven Spielberg film War of the Worlds. Blockbuster ordered 100,000 copies, which inspired The Asylum to focus on mockbusters. This led to a partnership with the television channel Syfy, and with the rise of video on demand (VOD) services in the early 2010s, partnerships with Pluto

TV and Tubi. The Asylum's greatest success came in 2013 with the film Sharknado, which is about a waterspout that lifts sharks out of the ocean and drops them over Los Angeles. The over-the-top premise went viral, and led to the creation of the Sharknado franchise. In response to the popularity of Sharknado, Syfy commissioned The Asylum to produce a zombie television series called Z Nation, which ran for five seasons.

The financing entity was founded by former Dune partner Chip Seelig with majority funding from Magnetar Capital with additional funding from Seelig and others. Seelig had left Dune in May 2011 to launch a new funding company. TSG was also looking for some (\$300–400 million) debt financing from banks at this time. In November 2015, Bona Film Group, a Chinese film studio, invested \$235 million in TSG. Because of The Walt Disney Company's acquisition of 21st Century Fox (sans certain units) on March 20, 2019, Disney inherited Fox's deal with TSG for 20th Century Fox (now 20th Century Studios).

UFO United Film Organisation

He formed the American Unified Film Organization in 1997 with Jeff Beach in Burbank, California. He recognized the growing demand in Science fiction and special effects driven action films. Since then his companies UFO and BUFO have produced many films. Roth has also opened a new four stage film and television center in Bulgaria.

UK Film Council

The UK Film Council (UKFC) was a non-departmental public body set up in 2000 to develop and promote the film industry in the UK. It was constituted as a private company limited by guarantee, owned by the Secretary of State for Culture, Media and Sport, and governed by a board of 15 directors. It was funded from various sources including The National Lottery. John Woodward was the Chief Executive Officer of the UKFC. In June 2008, the company had 90 full-time members of staff. It distributed more than £160m of lottery money to over 900 films. Lord Puttnam described the council as "a layer of strategic glue that's helped bind the many parts of our disparate industry together." On 26 July 2010, the government announced that the council would be abolished. UKFC closed on 31 March 2011, with many of its functions passing to the British Film Institute. Formation and leadership In 1999, Alan Parker was appointed as the chairman of the Film Council, with Stewart Till as the vice-chairman. Till became chairman after Parker left.

THE MISSION We're representing films at many of the major Film/TV markets, including the American Film Market (Los Angeles), EFM (Berlin), FilmArt (Hong Kong), NATPE (Miami), MIPTV & MIPCOM (Cannes) and the Cannes Film Festival/Market. THE FILMS We're interested in ALL GENRES of feature films & documentaries. We represent some films for commercial reasons (i.e., it's an easy sell) & we represent other films simply because we feel it's a work of art that needs to be recognized.

THE MONEY Phil Gorn is an independent filmmaker and has experienced many deals in the last 10 years. His earlier dealings for his own independent films usually ended with him seeing no money whatsoever. He's signed his films with sales agents and – although on paper it looked as if he was receiving 75% or even 80% - the expenses always seemed to be higher than the money owed. That's the reality for many of the independent filmmakers. Now we know better and we're trying to change this reality – attempting to be a safe island in a sea of sharks.

THE BOTTOM LINE If the producer isn't happy, then we're not happy. If the producer wants out of the contract, we make it very easy for this to happen. We don't want to hold onto a producer's film if they no longer want our representation. We've tried to take the sting out of signing away your film. We will simply do our best & if that isn't good enough, then you'll be free to go elsewhere. But, hopefully, we will all be ecstatic to work together, make lots of money & live happily ever after.

Xcelerator Media

XLrator Media is an American film distributor headquartered in Los Angeles, California. The CEO is Barry Gordon, who founded the company in April 2010. In 2014, they began offering film production services in partnership with other companies. Barry Gordon founded XLrator Media in April 2010. XLrator acts as a releasing company and partners with ARC Entertainment for the physical distribution. Gordon said that their market is films with an acquisition cost in "the low-seven-figure range". In 2012, XLrator launched the label Turbo for international action films, partnered with Scremfest Horror Film

Festival to create a horror-themed label curated by them, and created their own genre film label, Macabre. In 2014, XLrator partnered with New Artists Alliance to co-produce and distribute three science fiction films, and in 2015, they partnered with RNR to co-produce and distribute three action-thriller films. The same year, the Macabre label was made available on Hulu, an online video service. In 2016, they partnered with Rugged Entertainment to create the Lifeline documentary label and partnered with Blue Fox Entertainment to distribute fifteen genre films per year, starting in October 2016.

Previous XYZ/Resolute collaborations include Matt Johnson’s “Operation Avalanche,” which premiered at Sundance in 2016 and was released by Lionsgate; Anthony Scott Burns’ supernatural thriller “Our House,...

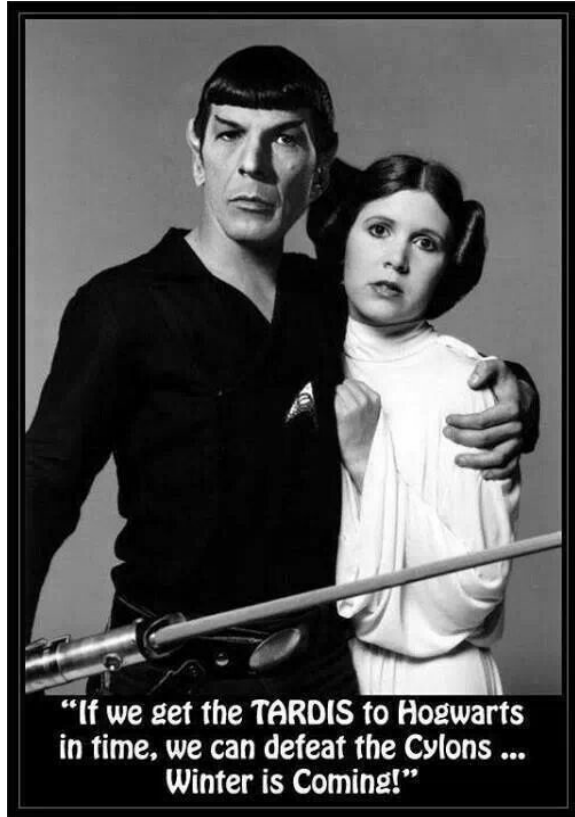
